COTSWOLD AIRPORT AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP 2018 – TERMS OF APPLICATION

6th to 17th August 2018 Monday to Friday

1. Acceptance of the terms and conditions contained herein is a condition of application for 2018 Cotswold Airport Aviation Scholarship (the “**Scholarship**”).

Eligibility

2. Applicants MUST be aged between 14 and 18 years old on the 6th August 2018.
3. Applicants must be resident within Gloucestershire, Wiltshire, Oxfordshire, Berkshire or Bristol and able to produce proof of address if required.

Application Process

4. To apply for the Scholarship, the attached application form must be completed and submitted by no later than 30 March 2018 in order to be considered for the Scholarship.
5. Cotswold Airport reserves the right to make reasonable changes to this application and these terms and conditions at any time and will advise applicants, as and when required.

Selection Process/Outcome of Application

6. If successful, the Scholarship offer letter outlines how to accept or reject the Scholarship. If the applicant does not respond to the Scholarship offer by the date outlined in the offer letter, the Scholarship offer will be rescinded.
7. Selection of successful applicants will be a two-stage process. The initial pool of applicants will be reduced to 20 who will then be invited to attend a dedicated selection interview on Saturday 21st April. Successful applicants will be advised of their offer of a place on the course by 27th April 2018.
8. The Cotswold Airport Aviation Scholarship panel decides who will be awarded a Scholarship based on the quality and content of the application submitted and the Scholarship panel's decisions are final.
9. Cotswold Airport may request evidence to support applications where necessary. All evidence must be received by the application closing date.
10. Applicants will be notified of they have been successful at any stage by email.

11. Due to the large volume of applications anticipated, only those who supply a VALID email address will be informed in the event that their application is unsuccessful. Applicants will not be notified by any other form.

12. Resources do not allow for unsuccessful applicants to be provided with feedback.

Conduct and Behaviour

13. Scholars shall conduct themselves at all times in a professional and polite manner whilst at Cotswold Airport.

14. Cotswold Airport requires its scholars to maintain an appropriate standard of behaviour throughout their Scholarship, taking into account the risks associated with, nature of and the location of such activities.

15. Cotswold Airport may suspend a scholar's participation in any Scholarship activities if Cotswold Airport reasonably suspects that they are under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

Data and information

16. All applicants agree to allow us to share certain data with other parties within Cotswold Airport and our affiliates.

17. Successful applicants or a parent or guardian will be asked to sign a consent form prior to commencement of the Scholarship so that Cotswold Airport may capture video and photographs of the scholar throughout the Scholarship or conduct interviews. The scholar agrees to feature in promotional material which shall include but shall not be limited to broadcast media, printed publications and online materials. The scholar accepts that he shall not receive remuneration for use of his name and promotional material.

18. Successful applicants or a parent or guardian must sign the medical consent and declaration form provided to them by Cotswold Airport, prior to commencement of the Scholarship in order to participate. The form asks Scholars to provide next of kin information as well as details of any medical conditions.

Cancellation

19. Cotswold Airport reserves the right to investigate and possibly withdraw a person from the Scholarship programme.

20. Cotswold Airport is not responsible for cancelled programs, cancelled flights or any other instance in which the recipient's intended Scholarship does not take place.

21. Cotswold Airport reserves the right to amend or withdraw Scholarships at any time Scholars may be stopped from participating by the organisers or marshals for any reason including if they cannot or do not comply with the relevant safety standards or requirements.

Safety

22. Applicants must wear such protective and safety equipment as directed by Cotswold Airport or its affiliates or representatives including steel toe capped shoes/boots as and when requested to do so. High Vis waistcoats will be provided and must be worn airside at all times.

23. Scholars must at all times follow the instructions of Cotswold Airport, the organisers and such other representatives and accept that the decision of the organisers in respect of safety matters is final.

Limitation of liability

24. Scholars agree that, save in respect of death or personal injury caused by the negligence of Cotswold Airport and its affiliates, to hold harmless, indemnify and keep indemnified Cotswold Airport and its affiliates (including officers, employees and promoters and organisers of the event) from and against all claims, liabilities, costs and expenses arising as a result of the applicants acts, omissions or carelessness including negligence. For example, the Applicant shall be responsible for any damage to the airport, aircraft or any facilities or equipment at the airport which is caused by anything done or not done by the applicant.

25. Save in respect of:

- death or personal injury caused by Cotswold Airports negligence or the negligence of its employees, agents or subcontractors;
- fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation; or
- any other liability which cannot be excluded or limited by law,

Cotswold airport shall under no circumstances whatsoever be liable to any applicant whether in contract, tort (including negligence), breach of statutory duty or otherwise.
