## **COTSWOLD AIRPORT AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP 2024 – TERMS OF APPLICATION**

1. Acceptance of the terms and conditions contained herein is a condition of application for a 2024 Cotswold Airport Aviation Scholarship.
2. Applicants must be aged between 15 and 18 years old on the 5th August 2024
3. Applicants must be resident within Gloucestershire, Wiltshire, Bristol and Avon, Berkshire, or Oxfordshire and able to produce proof of address if required.
4. Selection of candidates will be a two-stage process. The initial pool of applicants will be reduced to 16 candidates who will then be invited to attend a dedicated selection day. Further details of this will be communicated to successful candidates in June.
5. Due to the large volume of applications anticipated every year, only those who supply a valid email address will be informed in the event that their application is unsuccessful.
6. Conditions of flight: these sound a little scary and are designed to cover every eventuality, no matter how remote! Flying is not a dangerous occupation, but all risks must be treated sensibly and with respect.

6.1 Candidates must accept all risks inherent in light aviation in choosing to participate in this scheme.

6.2 Candidates must all wear protective and safety equipment as directed including steel toe capped shoes/boots at all times during the course of the Scholarship programme. Excluding when flying.

6.3 Candidates must at all times follow the instructions of the organisers and marshals and accept that the decision of the organisers in respect of safety matters is final.

6.4 Candidates may be stopped from participating by the organisers or marshals for any reason including if they cannot or do not comply with the relevant safety standards or requirements.

6.5 Candidates must agree that, save in respect of death or personal injury caused by the negligence of Cotswold Airport and its affiliates, to hold harmless, indemnify and keep indemnified Cotswold Airport and its affiliates. (Including officers, employees and promoters and organisers of the event) from and against all claims, liabilities, costs and expenses arising as a result of death or personal injury of the candidate or others caused by negligence or carelessness on the part of the candidate.
